- If you wish to audition for more than one character, you only need to sign up for one timeslot. You will be given the opportunity to read/sing for multiple characters during that time.
- Please be familiar with the audition materials for the role(s) you wish to audition for. It is not necessary to memorize the audition materials.
- Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your audition time.

WHAT TO BRING

- Completed Audition Form we suggest that all auditionees review all audition-related materials and complete their audition form *prior* to arriving for their audition slot. If you are unable to bring your completed audition form, we will have additional copies available to fill out. Please arrive in plenty of time to complete your form prior to your audition timeslot.
- Headshot If you <u>have not been</u> in a production with GTC before, please bring a headshot (photo of
 yourself from your shoulders up). Prior cast members as well, please.
- Resume Please provide a performance resume, listing your theater experience, training, and any special talents you feel would be a valuable asset to theater productions.

REHEARSALS

Bringing a fantastic production such as The Drowsy Chaperone, Jr. to life requires a lot of passion and commitment. With such a dynamic cast required, we cannot stress enough the importance of our rehearsal times together. When even one person is absent, everyone feels it, as we play off each other in each and every scene we perform together. If cast in this show, please make it a priority to be at every rehearsal you are scheduled to be part of.

For this show, we will begin with 2 week of full-cast music rehearsals, followed by the regular rehearsal schedule.

• Rehearsals are typically run be scene-by-scene, but please refer to the Rehearsal Calendar to confirm.

Please note that if you are in a scene being rehearsed, you need to be at rehearsal. Otherwise, you will not be required to attend. All lines and songs must be memorized before the rehearsal for the scene being blocked or choreographed.

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE EXPECTATIONS

While rehearsal schedules are prepared in advance of shows, it is important to know what to expect. The directors will do their utmost to finish ALL rehearsals at the stated rehearsal time on the rehearsal calendar, even if blocking is incomplete. This is why we need everyone to be at every rehearsal they are called for.

If for any reason a rehearsal looks as if it must run long because of complicated choreography, the directors will have cast members call to give a new ending time; however, the directors will do everything in their power to make sure this does not happen.

Two to three weeks prior to opening night, be prepared to attend every rehearsal, which is typically every day. These will be full run-throughs of Acts, and will include several dress rehearsals.

IMPORTANT DATES

Cast Meet-and-Greet – Our first opportunity as a cast to meet one another, receive scripts, and briefly go over details related to the show.

Regular Rehearsals – These rehearsals will be scene-by-scene, based on the rehearsal calendar provided.

Cast Party – Sunday, June 29th, after show cleanup until 9:00pm. More details to be announced.

Show Cleanup – Sunday, June 29th at 4:00pm. Although the performances are over, all cast and crew members are expected to assist in the teardown of the stage, storage of props, and resetting of the building facilities. Thank you in advance for helping serve in this capacity.

COSTUMES

Cast members will be responsible for providing their own shoes, socks/hosiery, and certain costume pieces. This will be communicated by the Director to you in advance of performances.

Stage shoes – We request that cast members have approved shoes sooner than later, to get used to wearing them during scenes. The type of shoe needed for your character(s) should be communicated to you by the Director and/or Costumer, but please do not hesitate to ask. Once you have the shoes, please ask the Director for final approval.
